Reservation: 15% of the total seats are reserved for scheduled castes and 7% seats for scheduled tribes. Out of the remaining, 67% of the seats will be reserved for boys from Nagaland State. Balance 33% left over of seats will be thrown open to boys from other States and Union Territories in the ratio of their male population. Any unutilized seats in this category will be merged with home State seats in order of merit.

25% seats (Home State Defence and all India Defence) are reserved for children of Defence personnel including Ex-servicemen.
