SUB: Decision to change the category of schools run by the society created by the different Ministry / Department / Govt. Body / Undertaking -- reg.

Sir,

You are aware that as per rule 3.1 under chapter - II of Affiliation Bye-Laws, the Board affiliates several categories of school all over India and Abroad, as for example:-

- (i) Government or Government aided schools;
- (ii) Schools run by autonomous Organisations under the Government like Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS), Central Tibetan Schools Organisation (CTSO), Sainik Schools Society etc.
- (iii) Schools run by Government Department directly like Defence, Railways etc.
- (iv) Schools managed directly by Public Sector Undertakings or by reputed societies for Public Sector Undertakings under the financial control of such Public Sector Undertakings or by Societies formed by such undertakings.
- (v) Private, unaided schools established by societies registered under the societies Registration act, 1860 of the Government of India or under Acts of the State Governments as educational, charitable or religious societies having non-proprietary character with certain condition.

As of now, Sainik Schools, Rashtriya School, Army Schools /Army Public Schools, Naval Schools /Naval Public Schools, Air force Schools and schools run by different Ministries / Departments directly or indirectly by creating their own societies have been put under the Independent category of school considering that these schools are run by Ministries / Departments / Undertakings other than Education Department of Central / State / U.T Govt. resulting to non admissibility of certain relaxation / benefits which are available to Govt. / Govt. aided schools.

New Affiliation No. 1480002

Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 13.1.2011 and subsequent inspection of the school, I am directed to convey sanction for provisional affiliation to the above said school for **Senior School Certificate Examination** for a period of three years w.e.f. 1.4.2011 to 31.3.2015 in the following subjects:-

(a) **Languages:-**

English Core, English Elective, Hindi Core, Hindi Elective

(b) **Elective Subjects:**

Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer Science

The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:

1. "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."
2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X.
3. As per the newly implemented CCE scheme vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009, the students of class X will appear in the Summative Assessment-II (SA-II) conducted at the school level only. However, those students of class X, who opt to move out of CBSE system in Class XI to any other Board, will exercise the option to appear in the SA-II conducted at the Board level. Both the students will get the same certificate issued by the Board at the end of class X.
4. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT.
5. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
6. The school will provide additional suitable facilities for classes XI and XII, as per requirements laid down in the rules.
7. It will increase the number of books in the Library and equipments in the Laboratories/Workshops with adequate games facilities etc. in consonance with the requirements of the Board for Classes XI & XII.
8. It will appoint only qualified staff to teach Classes XI & XII as per requirements laid down by the Board.
9. It will provide facilities for adequate co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the wholesome development of the students.
10. It will abide itself by the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board and other rules and regulations prescribed by the Board from time to time.

Other Conditions:

Conditions for which compliance to be submitted within three months from the date of issue of sanction letter:-

1. Running starting of Class IX/X & XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level/Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorized and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. Non-submission of application for extension of provisional affiliation by 30th June of the year preceding to the year by which provisional affiliation granted, expires, would also attract violation of provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws.
3. School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE Affiliated school building/premises.
4. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
5. Pay & Allowances to staff should be revised from time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government.
6. The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and Staff be given appointment/confirmation letters etc. accordingly.
7. 5-6 names of persons (at least 2-3 from KV/JNV) not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee.
8. The school shall maintain section teacher ratio at least 1:1.5 at each level i.e. Primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. Secondary (XI-XII).
9. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaska and other State of Rajasthan and others delivered on 13.8.1997.
10. The school shall maintain Reserve Fund in the joint names of the Manager of the school concerned and the Secretary of the Board in the scheduled Bank to the extent indicated below:-

501	-	750	"	Rs.80, 000/-
751	-	1000	"	Rs.1, 00,000/-
Above	-	1000	"	Rs. 100/- per student rounded to nearest thousand.

The interest accruing out of the deposit of reserve fund made by the Institution at the time of affiliation/extension of affiliation be not withdrawn by the management under any circumstances what so ever.

13. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
14. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation on the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee of ₹ 25,000/- and other essential documents in the preceding year before the expiry of the date.
15. The school will open CBSE pattern classes XI w.e.f. 1.4.2012. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class XII of the school will be appearing at the CBSE Examination to be held in 2014.
16. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.
17. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-
- The Affiliation Committee in its meeting held on 24.5.2012 and the Govt. Body of the Board in its meeting held on 4.6.2012 has approved the proposal to consider the Sainik Schools, Rashtriya Military School, Army Schools, Navy Schools, Air Force School and schools run by State Govt./MHRD/Different Ministry/Departments directly or by creating their own Society by the respective Department/Ministry under the category of Govt. schools and the provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws applicable for Govt. and Govt. aided schools would be applicable on these schools. In the light of same, the school is being treated as Govt. school category. The New Affiliation Number applicable being a Govt. category school will be intimated very soon.
 - The PTI is not qualified. Therefore, a qualified PTI may be appointed immediately.
 - The school is required to appoint 02 TGTs besides the existing staff to meet the required section teacher ratio 1:1.5 teachers per section, as per present strength.
